Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 06 (two sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 30 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school, as per affiliation bye law and subject to availability of class rooms with greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school is required to submit the renewed / permanent recognition certificate within 03 months in the compliance.
3	The land certificate is not as per the prescribed format and it is issued in 2021. Further, details of the lessor (as per details given on Sl. No. 05 and 06) with land title / type of ownership is not mentioned in the same. Thus, the school is required to obtain renewed land certificate as per format i.e. appendix – X as prescribed in circular no. 12/2022 within 03 months and submit the same in the compliance.
4	As per application, school has 02 blocks. However, the building safety certificate does not have details of both the blocks and validity. Thus, the school is required to obtain renewed Building Safety Certificate as per prescribed format issued by an officer not below the rank of an Assistant Engineer of the Government works department including the number of blocks & floors with validity within 03 months and submit the same in the compliance.

5	The school is required to appoint female member as head of sexual harassment committee within 03 months and submit the documentary evidence in the compliance.
6	The school does not have provision for CwSN. Thus, the school is required to implement the same i.e. ramp at ground level, ramp / lift to access upper floors and CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The boundary wall is partially covered in the inspection videography. Thus, the school is required to ensure that it should be bounded with concrete wall from all sides within minimum 6 ft of height and submit the videography link covering entire boundary wall from all sides in continuity within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	The mathematics lab is under stocked and temporarily arranged on make-shift tables with insufficient storage and no seating facility. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the same as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
9	The all three science labs do not have seating arrangement (wooden stools) and sufficient storage facility. Further, the chemistry lab does not have safety features such as fire extinguisher and exhaust fan. Thus, the school is required to set-up the same as per above in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance
10	The composite science lab does not have seating arrangement (wooden stools), gas connection in the workstation and safety features such as fire extinguisher and exhaust fan. Thus, the school is required to set-up the same as per above in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
11	The school does not have sufficient books for senior level and it does not have separate reading space for staff. Thus, the school is required to procure more books and create separate reading space for staff within 03 months and submit the invoice with videography in the compliance.
12	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
